



Ring size guide

To measure the circumference of the finger or the diameter of a ring

Choose the most suitable size by measuring the diameter of a ring you already own or the circumference of the finger where you would like to wear the ring. The measurement table that follows will help you to find the size that is closest to your needs.

To measure the circumference of the finger

1. Take a measuring tape, string or strip of paper.
2. Wrap it around the finger where you will wear the ring and mark the point where the ends join.
3. Lay the string or paper strip on a flat surface and use a ruler to measure the length to the point you marked.
4. Use the table above to find the ring size that comes closest to your needs.

To measure the diameter of a ring:

1. Choose a ring that already fits well on your finger.
2. Measure the inside diameter of the ring in millimeters (mm).
3. Lay the string or paper strip on a flat surface and use a ruler to measure the length to the point you marked.
3. Use the table above to find the ring size that comes closest to your needs.
